STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2018

PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP:

The AIA Grand Rapids student scholarship was established to recognize a deserving architecture student who has chosen to continue his/her professional architectural education attending an architecture program at one of the following; Andrews University, Ferris State University, Kendall College of Art and Design, Lawrence Technological University, University of Detroit Mercy, University of Michigan, or an NAAB-accredited program in architecture for tuition, books, and other educational-related fees. The scholarship recognizes characteristics and qualities critical to achieving success in the architectural profession, including academic competency, leadership potential, and appreciation of the built environment.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:

The AIA Grand Rapids student scholarship recipient(s) will be provided a \$1,000 scholarship to be applied to the cost of attending an architecture degree program, including tuition, books, and other educational-related expenses. The scholarship is for one year.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY:

To be considered for selection, the following criteria must be met:

1. The applicant must be enrolled in an architecture program at one of the aforementioned schools or NAAB-accredited Masters of Architecture Degree program.
2. The applicant must be a junior, senior, or master degree candidate with at least one year left to complete his/her architectural degree.
3. The applicant must be a resident of West Michigan in the area encompassed by the AIA Grand Rapids chapter. This includes the counties of Ionia, Kent, Lake, Mason, Mecosta, Montcalm, Muskegon, Newaygo, Oceana, Osceola, and Ottawa.
4. The applicant should demonstrate enthusiasm and participation in areas of the built environment. Participation in school activities or leadership roles in other organizations may be considered.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

The following procedures are required for consideration:

1. Complete the biographical data section of this application, including extracurricular activity involvement and employment history.
2. Forward official transcript(s) from high school (optional) and all colleges/universities attended to: Gary Gerber, AIA, 7602 Belmont Avenue NE, Belmont, MI 49306.
3. Write an essay (one to three double-spaced, typed pages) explaining why you deserve to be an AIA Grand Rapids student scholarship recipient, including long-term personal and career goals.
4. Submit two academic/faculty references of your choice (in sealed envelope).
5. Submit one personal reference of your choice (in sealed envelope).
6. Submit application, essay, references (three) to Gary Gerber, AIA, 7602 Belmont Avenue NE, Belmont, MI 49306.

The AIA Grand Rapids chapter president, past president, and Gary Gerber, AIA, continuing education director, will select the scholarship recipient(s) from submitted applications.

AIA Grand Rapids student scholarship applications must be postmarked no later than April 9, 2018. Announcement of the winning recipient will be made no later than May 14, 2018.
